CRVS systems register and track key events in people's lives. They provide crucial legal documentation and are foundational for both gender equality and data equality. Yet despite their importance, in many countries CRVS systems are incomplete or underused, locking women and girls out of basic rights and services.

CRVS systems make women visible at key life moments, providing an official record of their status.




